

Von Braun Deplores Ban on Oppenheimer

WASHINGTON, March 14 (UP)—Dr. Wernher von Braun agreed today that it was tragic that the United States was not using the services of Dr. J. Robert Oppenheimer, the atomic physicist whose security clearance was withdrawn four years ago.

Dr. von Braun, German-born rocket expert, spoke in behalf of Dr. Oppenheimer, in response to a question at a House hearing. He was called to give his ideas on education problems.

Dr. von Braun added that he was not in a position to comment on "security aspects," but, he said, "I think the British would have knighted him."
